As a reminder, the **NHLC Preservation Trust** was awarded 501 (C)(3) nonprofit designation in 2017, with the main focus of historic preservation of our building at 193 Whitney Avenue, a National Historic Landmark. In addition the NHLC Preservation Trust will provide educational and historic programming open to the public promoting urban revitalization and combating urban decline.

Recent NHLC Preservation Trust Projects:

2021 - Removal and Replacement of the 19 finials that adorn the roof of the clubhouse - through prior year fundraising efforts, including several major donor gifts, the Preservation Trust raised over \$18,000 to cover the cost of this project.

Compelling storytelling involves a deep understanding of human emotions, motivations, and psychology.
